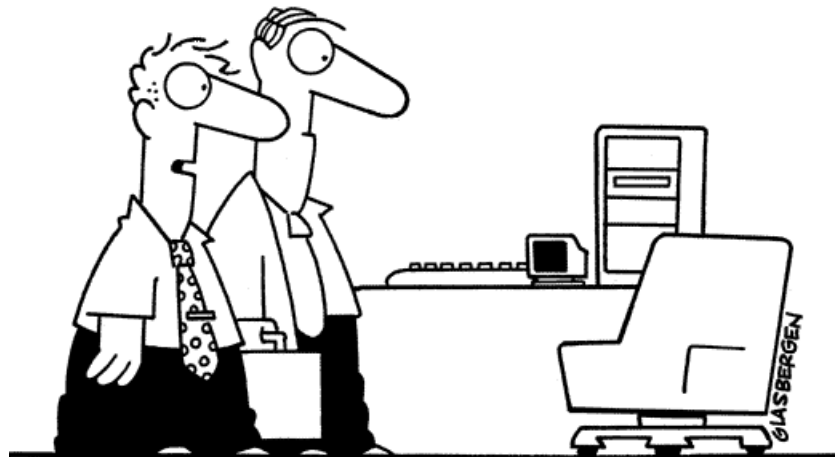


Communication at WorldCom
