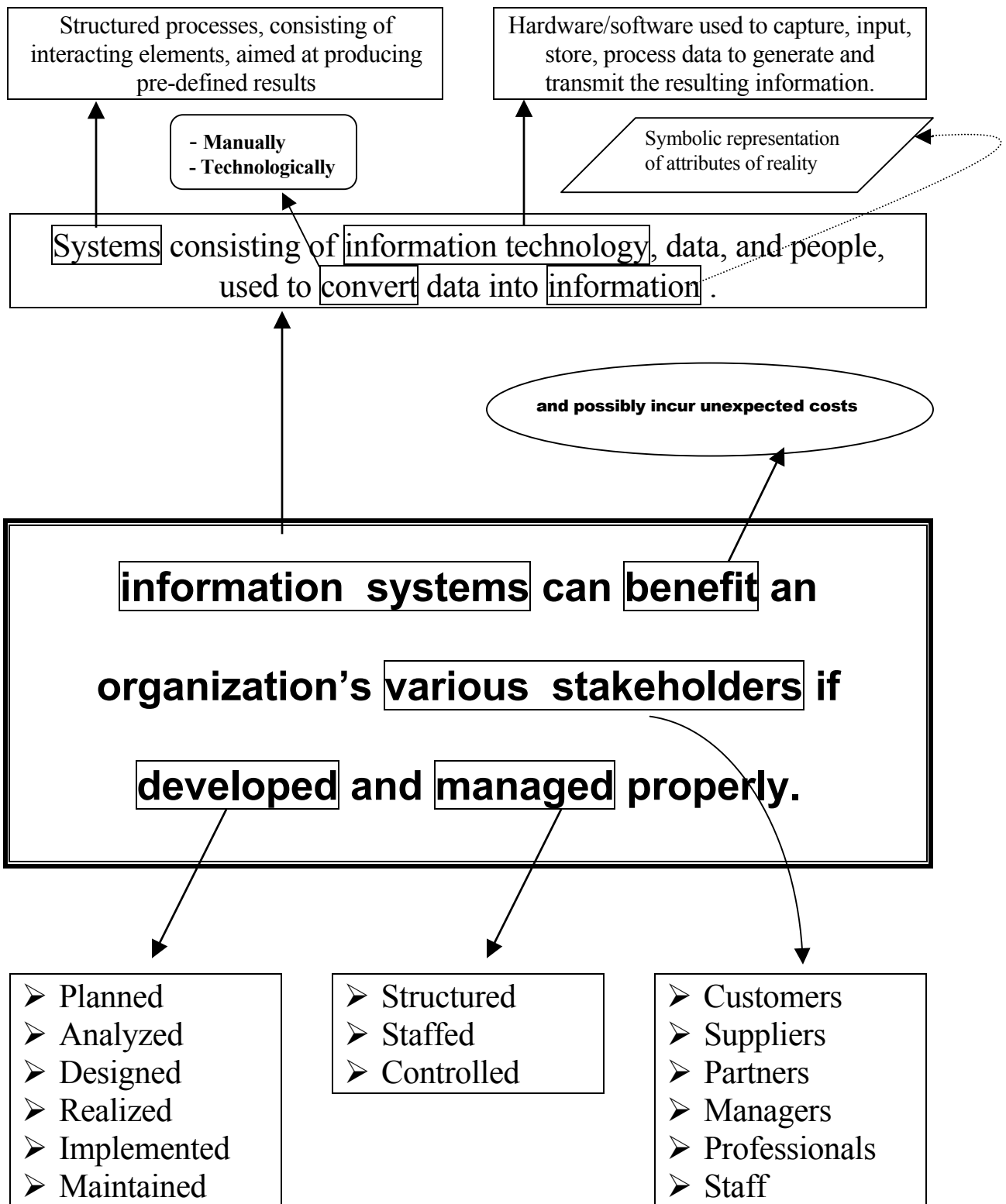
Is This an I.S.-Related Problem?

1. You call a hotel to make a reservation. It takes fifteen minutes to make this reservation, and you are issued a confirmation number which you are asked to present later at registration time.
2. A secretary schedules a meeting of four managers, only to find out that one of them is not free at the designated time. By the time the meeting is rescheduled, another one calls in to say that she will be unavailable at the rescheduled time.
3. A customer is reluctant to place an order with your firm and is considering switching to your competitor because, in the past, he has been quoted one price and charged another, and also because his production plan has been sometimes disrupted by late delivery.
4. A customer has sued your firm. Because of your lack of experience in legal matters, you lose the suit, pay the customer for all damages, and also generate much negative publicity for your firm.
5. The new plant your company recently built has a much higher overall transportation cost (*from* its suppliers, and *to* its major markets) than you had anticipated. You are wondering if building the plant at another location would have significantly lowered the overall transportation cost.
6. You pay a vendor the full amount due on an invoice, only to realize later that the shipment against which the payment was made was 30% damaged.

7. Fifteen managers from two regional offices are flown 6,000 miles away to corporate headquarters for a relatively short meeting, resulting in high travel expense and lack of productivity (travel preparation, flight time, jet lag, and so forth).

8. A sales manager sees a semiannual report that, to her surprise, indicates about sixty percent of her salespeople have consistently missed their sales quotas over the past nine months.
